Broadly speaking, my research centers on examining the extent to which policy and policy changes inform and impact practice within the context of sport, recreation, physical activity, and higher education. More specifically, my interests focus on investigating: (1) the interplay between alcohol and sport-specific events, activities, and services; (2) outreach initiatives utilizing sport for development and social change; and (3) workplace and human resource management practices in professional sports, intercollegiate athletics, and higher education. Within these areas, my colleagues and I have submitted over \$4.9 million in federal funding and external contracts.
